

## Federal Internships for Newcomers - Job Opportunities

The Federal Internship for Newcomers (FIN) Program, delivered through Citizenship and Immigration Canada (CIC), is designed to provide eligible newcomers with the opportunity to gain valuable Canadian work experience within the federal government for a specified period.

**Department Name:** Citizenship and Immigration Canada, Human Resources and Skills Development Canada and various other federal departments, agencies and crown corporations.

**Location:** Ottawa-Gatineau, Greater Toronto Area, and Greater Vancouver/Victoria

**Application Date:** June 13<sup>th</sup> - 14<sup>th</sup> 2011

**Employment Tenure:** Casual temporary employment.

### Who can apply?

- Persons residing or employed in Greater Vancouver Area/Victoria, Greater Toronto Area, and Ottawa/Gatineau
- Permanent residents and Canadian citizens who have been in Canada less than 10 years.
- Candidates who have been successfully screened for employment readiness (screening includes, an in person meeting and assessment, assessment of functional language capacity in English and/or French (minimum Canadian Language Benchmark of 5-8, referral to appropriate learning/assessment bodies or credential assessment, and referral to job readiness training where needed i.e. resume writing or interviewing coaching) by a partnering Immigrant Serving Organization (ISO)
